Old Business:

Assistant Manager - Pretty much up to speed; opening, scheduling, PayPal refunds, managing website. Need to determine amount of time Taylor has spent assisting.

Fees reduction - Received lots of positive feedback from pool users. We will keep monitoring.

PPP Loan - We were granted new loan middle of February. Bruce is tracking expenses that qualify and at the time all funds are spent will apply for "forgiveness". Expect that to be about the middle of April.

No word on the CA grant that was applied for.

High School and Sea Serpent Schedules - The coached worked on a schedule and then approached Ives Pool and Ricardo. Schedule goes to May 20. Do not have dates for meets yet.

PG&E and Solar Panels - Power generation from panels keeps increasing. 2,000 Kilowatts saved by variable speed motor. Do not see a decrease in PG&E bills from a year ago but we do not receive our PG&E bill from the City on a regular/monthly basis. PG&E does a "settle up" once a year for the power we generate; Clean Power does it differently. Need to contact City about our bill.

Unclaimed Paychecks - Marilyn is working with accountant to follow State process for transferring funds to State system for unclaimed funds.
